CALL TO ORDER

In connection with the proposed Petroglyph mitigation plan, it was mentioned that the County and Petroglyph have an agreement, and the brine water is being used by the County to spray dirt roads around River Ridge.

Water case 11CW45: Deborah Blouin, application for surface water rights (amended), Ojo Springs #1 (80 gpm absolute) and #2 (20 gpm conditional), natural springs of the Cucharas River. The Board discussed that augmentation water would be required and a SWSP should be developed for this application. In order to get more information, there was a Mace motion, seconded by Jordan, to file a protest on this case. Harriman will take care of the initial filing. There was a Jerant motion, seconded by Mace, to authorize payment of the \$158 filing fee. Board approved.
